Kids' Orchestra is the largest elementary-age after school music program in the country. Approaching its sixth year, Kids' Orchestra provides opportunities for 800 kindergarten through fifth graders in the Baton Rouge community to study an instrument, play in an orchestra, or sing in a choir.

Kids' Orchestra's mission is to bring children of all cultures and backgrounds together using music education as a vehicle to foster teamwork, develop understanding and emphasize excellence.

Kids' Orchestra is currently seeking qualified collaborative pianist to join our team for the 2016/2017 school year.

Collaborative Pianist: Kids' Orchestra is launching the Kids' Orchestra Community Choir of Baton Rouge (KOCCBR) in August, 2016. The program is open to all students in Baton Rouge, grades 2-6, and is directed by Dr. Melissa Brunkan and Mr. Jason Bowers. Ideal candidates should be highly skilled in piano accompaniment and sight-reading, and must be willing to work with choir directors and beginning choral students. - Prior experience working with children in a music environment
- Exceptional verbal communication skills
- Willingness to make accommodations for students of varying abilities and levels
- Enthusiasm for the mission of KO is a must

- Thorough preparation and organization of choral repertoire
- Assist choir directors as they prepare students for a minimum of two concerts per school year (December and May)
- Ensure that all children arrive, learn, and leave our care in a safe environment
