Cross off each box that you are able to complete while you are out of school. See how many you can do!

Create a new folk dance using moves we learned in class.	Create a song in ABA form about the weather.	Sing a song you remember from last year's music class.	Time how long you can sing one note. See if you can beat your record.	Listen to 3 pieces of music. Decide if the tempo is slow, medium or fast for each.
Write down what emotions your favorite song makes you feel.	Watch a movie and write a paragraph about how the music helps to tell the story.	Listen to a piece of music with no words and write a story that the music tells.	Listen to a piece of music and make a list of all the instruments you can hear.	Teach your parents a song you've learned at school.
Choose a song, and write a paragraph to convince me why we should perform it.	Create a piece of music in ABA form using only body percussion.	Sing all the songs you remember from this year so far.	Find and listen to a piece of music that has the beat in groups of 4 and another in groups of 3.	Tell me about a song you don't like at all. Write down 3 reasons you can't stand it.
Tell me about a piece of music that triggers a memory for you.	Improvise a drum solo using only objects in your bedroom.	Make up a song to describe your day today.	Make a song that only uses one word.	Make a list of 10 reasons that people listen to music all over the world.
List the top 10 most important places music should exist.	Be silent for 5 minutes and write down all the sounds you hear.	Imagine a world with no music. Write 5 sentences describing how it would be different.	What is the difference between music and sound? Make a venn diagram to show your thoughts.	What would the soundtrack to your life sound like?
